*OSHC (Overseas Student Health Cover): The Australian Government requires all international students and their dependents, studying on a student visa to maintain acceptable health and medical insurance during their entire stay in Australia. OSHC provides medical and hospital cover for international students and their dependents whilst studying in Australia.
